FROM OUR BOARD PRESIDENT GEORGE FORCIER

One question I am often asked is why GSPHS is not located in the more populated centers of Sarasota County, such as the cities of Sarasota or Venice. GSPHS is located in Nokomis, approximately half way between the two extremes of Sarasota County on Tamiami Trail, the most traveled road in the county except for the interstate highway. This location is also located at a bus stop. Although Sarasota County does offer health services (on a sliding payment scale) for uninsured financially needy members of our community, their facilities are located at the two ends of Sarasota County in the cities of Sarasota and in North Port. These locations are not very convenient to patients living in the center of the county, and consequently, patients in the center of the county may neglect their health care due to these travel requirements.

In addition, the site of our location is also dictated by its' affordability. GSPHS has approximately 3,000 square feet of working space. Although it is not ideally suited for use as a pharmacy and physician exam rooms, it is extremely affordable thanks to our landlord, who pays a significant portion of our monthly rental cost because he believes in our mission. Any savings from the monthly rent payment is better used for providing health care services. Recently, GSPHS has obtained a generous grant from the William G. & Marie Selby Foundation and is in the process of modifying the facility to more suitably meet our needs.

Finally, GSPHS is blessed to have volunteers, who are among the very best and have a "can do" attitude. Therefore, even if the GSPHS facility may not be ideally suited for our use, our volunteers have always found a way to make it work. Due to the flexibility of our volunteers, patient services were not interrupted during the reconstruction period.
